Treasurer's Report: Fund balances as of February 28th were \$9,804.15 for general and \$11,782.63 for technical. Motion to approve treasurer report by Mrs. Rehberg; 2nd by Dr. Rustman. Motion carried.

The winner, Deb Shultz, generously donated her winnings back to the school, bringing the profit to \$220. It was noted that the amount of bake sale and dessert items was lower than in former years. In part, this could be due to the ongoing ask for contributions to bake sales for the past few months.

New Business:

1. **Upcoming Elections:** The positions of Vice-President and Treasurer will be voted on at the April meeting.
2. **Teacher Appreciation:** Teacher appreciation takes place in May. Planning/ideas will be discussed at our next meeting.
3. **Teacher Items:** Book-it pizza party will be coming up in April. A volunteer will be needed to pick up and deliver the pizza. Teachers will use the extra book-it coupons as they have in the past. We will need to make sure the pop machine is open for use during the party.

Emma Smith presented an idea for a new fundraiser. She has volunteered to inquire about %Donkey Basketball+
