Treasurer's Report: Fund balances as of December $31^{\text {st }}$ were $\$ 2,723.11$ for general and $\$ 15,790.92$ for technical. Motion to approve treasurer report by Dr. Rustman; $2^{\text {nd }}$ by Brooke Jacobs. Motion carried.

## Old Business:

1. Teacher Items: None
2. Uniforms:
a. Track: Ordered forty at $\$ 8.50 / \mathrm{ea}$. They will be forest green with a winged foot and will have Lisbon Track \& Field in white lettering. Boys will have a scoop neck and girls a V-neck. The order should be arriving soon.
b. Scholastic Bowl: Uniforms have been ordered and will be arriving shortly.
3. SCRIP: Made a profit of $\$ 372.52$ which is up $\$ 97$ from last year $\hat{S} \$ 275.10$.
4. Santa Shop: Made a profit of $\$ 619$, which is down $\$ 105$ from last year $\widehat{s} \$ 724$. It was suggested that in the future, inventory is documented thoroughly. This should include detailed records of what was purchased, what sold, as well as the profit for the items. All outside vendors need be mentioned to the board ahead of time, to alleviate any confusion of who is participating and how the profit breaks down.
5. Spirit Wear: Kirhoffer介̂s did wonderfully with our Walk-A-Thon needs, however wasnd as great with Spirit Wear. The lack of variety hurt our profit. In the future we will look into using Matt Thompson. It was decided to offer Spirit Wear at registration next year to avoid the busy Christmas season.

## New Business:

1. Pork Chop Dinner: Set for February $24^{\text {th }}$. Clearview Pork has given us prices for several options to be offered and they are as follows:

- One chop dinner- $\$ 6$ (weđl price at $\$ 9$ )
- Two chop dinner- \$7 (wedl price at \$10)
- Pork burger sandwich- $\$ 4.50$ (weđ price at $\$ 7$ )
- Butterfly pork chop sandwich- \$5 (weđl price at \$8)

Clearview was voted in at these prices offering these menu items. We will have containers of beans, applesauce, and potato chips. Both chop meals will come with a dinner roll as well, but sandwich meals will not. We plan to have a bake sale, 50/50 raffle, and also a tablet raffle or other items possibly if donated.
